ELEC2910 Academic and Professional Development I

Course Description

A compulsory, one year course for Electronic Engineering and EE (Information and Communication Engineering) students only. This course is designed to provide academic advising to students and/or to develop students' communication skills in interacting with the technical and non-technical audiences in their professional careers. Graded P or F.

List of Topics

Students are divided into a number of small groups. Each group is assigned an ECE faculty who meets with the group three times a year (once in Fall term, twice in Spring term) alternatively as a group and on an individual basis. Each student is also required to meet the communication tutor once in the Fall term.
