Notation:

The prerequisite of an ELEC 4000-level course is expressed in the form of (List 1) AND (List 2), where all courses belong to List # is labeled by # in the corresponding column, and the requirement is met if at least one course(s) in each list have been taken with a pass. In addition, * denotes a corequisite requirement.

e.g. ELEC 4330 has ELEC 2350 (2300) as a prerequisite and ELEC 3300 as a corequisite, which corresponds to List 1=(ELEC 2350) and List 2*=(ELEC3300).
